# C. Consider Resolution No. 2010-03, approving an amendment to the Jersey Village Crime Control and Prevention District Budget for fiscal year 2009-2010 (Police Department Expansion Project – HBL Reimbursable Expenses).

Michael Brown, Director of Parks and Recreation introduced the item. He explained that the Agreement with HBL Architects for work on the Police Department Expansion Project was signed on December 15, 2008. As part of that Agreement, there was a "not to exceed" clause for Architecture costs of \$72,000.00. However there was an exception to this clause in Section E of the Agreement that addressed "Reimbursable Expenses."

The "Reimbursable Expenses" incurred under Section E of the Agreement to date were outlined in a spreadsheet included in the Council packet, and currently total \$16,000.00; however, staff is asking for a budget amendment in the amount of \$22,000.00 to cover these

expenses, leaving a balance to cover any additional "Reimbursable Expenses" that might be incurred.
