The Crime Control and Prevention District's (CCPD) 2014-15 budget supplementals include the following:

- Four (4) vehicles for \$172,000
- > Taser Program for \$55,334
- > Repair of Police Building for \$5,500

Additionally, this fund will take on additional staffing positions that will no longer be funded by the Red Light Camera Fund.

The Board engaged in discussion concerning the budget presented, including the supplemental requests for budget year 2014-2015. There was concern that the fund is decreasing by some \$250,000 each year and will take about four (4) years before the fund balance is expended. As a result, the Board discussed projections and how expenditures will be funded in the coming years with the loss of the red light camera program revenue and the loss of sales tax dollars due to the expansion of US HWY 290.
