Vice President Hamley called upon Chief of Police, Eric Foerster to give a presentation on the CCPD budget. Accordingly, Chief of Police Eric Foerster outlined the four (4) supplementals being requested as follows:

In completing the presentation, Vice President Hamley gave a brief history of the Crime Control and Prevention District. He explained that the City collects a ½ cent sales tax for the District which is used for crime control. The CCPD was elected into being by the citizens of Jersey Village back in 1998 for a five (5) year period, was continued in 2003 for ten (10) years, and will be up for a continuation election in 2013. Vice President Hamley explained that there is a significant amount of dollars specifically collected for crime prevention as a result of this district.
