C. Consider Resolution No. 2017-04, amending the 2016-2017 Crime Control and Prevention District's Budget in the amount of \$35,007.00 and authorizing the purchase of a 2017 Chevrolet Tahoe from the Crime Control Prevention District Fund.

Chief of Police, Eric Foerster introduced the item. Background information is as follows:

On August 8, 2017, while responding to an accident scene, unit #1402, a 2014 Chevrolet Tahoe, was struck by a box truck and sustained major damage. The Tahoe was subsequently totaled by TML, the City's insurance provider.

Presently, the department is short one patrol unit and is requesting funding to purchase a new Tahoe to replace the totaled unit as soon as possible. The City has received a quote from Siddons Martin Emergency Group (Exhibit B), for a 2017 Chevrolet Tahoe for a total of \$53,282.00. Siddons Martin is a Buy Board contract vendor. After receiving an insurance settlement in the amount of \$18,275.00, the total funding required for the purchase is \$35,007.00.

The budget amendment moves the funds from the CCPD fund balance into the CCPD Budget – Equipment Purchase Contribution – 50-27-9781 (Exhibit A), and is subject to the approval of the City Council.

## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

In accordance with Sec. 363.204 (f) of the Local Government Code, the CCPD Board adopted the following procedures for adopting the annual budget:

- 1. <u>Public hearing before the Board required</u>. No later than the 21st day prior to the first month of each fiscal year of the District, the Board of Directors 'Board' shall hold a public hearing on the proposed annual budget for the upcoming fiscal year."
- 2. <u>Publication of time, date, and place of public hearing</u>. The Board shall publish notice of the time, date, and place of the public hearing on the proposed budget in a newspaper with general circulation in the District not later than the 7th day before the date of the hearing.
- 3. <u>Public hearing before the Board held</u>. At the public hearing conducted by the Board, all residents of the District are entitled to be present and participate in the hearing.
- 4. <u>Adoption of budget by the Board</u>. After the public hearing on the proposed budget, the Board shall adopt a budget for the upcoming fiscal year.
- 5. <u>Submission of budget to the City Council of the City of Jersey Village</u>. Within ten 10 days after the budget is adopted or deemed adopted by the Board, the Board shall submit the budget to the City Council of the City of Jersey Village, Texas the "City Council".
- 6. <u>Public hearing before the City Council required</u>. Not later than the 10th day prior to the first month of each fiscal year of the District, the City Council shall hold a public hearing on the budget adopted by the Board for the upcoming fiscal year.
- 7. <u>Publication of time, date, and place of public hearing</u>. The City Council shall publish notice of the time, date, and place of the public hearing on the budget adopted by the District in a newspaper with general circulation in the District not later than the 7th day before the date of the hearing.
- 8. <u>Public hearing before the City Council held</u>. At the public hearing conducted by the City Council of the City of Jersey Village, all residents of the District are entitled to be present and participate in the hearing.
- 9. <u>Approval of budget by the City Council</u>. After the public hearing on the District's budget, the City Council shall approve or reject the budget submitted by the Board. The City Council may not, on its own accord, amend the submitted budget. If the City Council rejects the submitted budget, the City Council and the Board shall meet and together approve a budget for the District.
- 10. <u>Amendment of the budget</u>. The Board may amend the District's budget after the beginning of the fiscal year with approval of the City Council.
